**3. Rosecrance Jackson Adolescent Crisis Stabilization Residential Services – Presentation – Brenda Cain**

Brenda shared information on their inpatient services. They serve ages 12-18 and treat co-occurring disorders (substance abuse and mental health). They provide trauma informed care, detox and stabilization, and have on-site schooling/education. Treatment plans are focused on the client and family. She will be sending out application/referral information that can be passed along.

#### **4. Community Based Crisis Stabilization**

Melissa Drey and Nicolle Eaton lead the discussion and updated on progress. MCAT is being looked at to provide triage as a first step in the process and to determine level of care.

Melissa and Nicolle will be setting up a meeting with Eyerly Ball in Des Moines to discuss how their services are working as it is similar to what we are discussing.
