2. Crisis Services Update – Ashley Miller & Nicolle Eaton

Ashley Miller shared they are continuing collaboration with SMHC and Seasons Center and are hoping to have the referral form out as soon as Seasons Center opens their new crisis home in November, there is no set date as of now. They have restarted community-based crisis services with two referrals in September and currently five referrals in October. Tracy DeLao is working on setting up ASIST trainings for 2025.

Nicolle Eaton shared they are waiting on the HHS redesign and anticipating whom will be the ASO. Last week the Governance Board agreed that PAMHC and SMHC will take over the deed of their properties with a prospective date of January 1, 2025. This means there will not be a lapse in services and they will continue to serve clients.

Caylyn Bishop shared the providers gave a crisis update to the Carroll County Board of Supervisors and received many great responses.
